LIABILITY RELEASE STATEMENT

Every entry at a recognized show shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that the person making it along with the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider, and the horse: 1) shall be subject to the constitution and rules of Bits & Spurs Riding Club, Evergreen Zone and Washington State Horsemen; 2) That every horse, rider and/or driver is eligible as entered; 3) That the owner and any of his representatives are bound by the constitution and rules of Bits & Spurs Riding Club, Evergreen Zone and Washington State Horsemen, and said owner and any of his representatives will accept as final the decision of show management on any question arising under said rules and agree to hold harmless Bits & Spurs Riding Club, Evergreen Zone and Washington State Horsemen, their officials, directors, and agents, employees and volunteers for any action taken; 4) That the owner, rider, driver, and any of their agents or representatives acknowledge that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that horse sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risk and by participating they expressly assume any and all risk of injury or loss, and they agree to hold harmless Bits & Spurs Riding Club, Evergreen Zone and Washington State Horsemen and their officials, directors, employees, volunteers, and agents for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show, whether or not such injury or loss resulted directly or indirectly from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees, or agents or the show, Bits & Spurs Riding Club, Evergreen Zone and Washington State Horsemen. All Junior Members (17 & Under) must wear a helmet at all times while mounted on either a horse or pony.

GENERAL SHOW RULES

1. **SIGNATURE:** Signature on entry denotes unconditional compliance and agreement with the Bits & Spurs Liability Release Statement below, and the Evergreen Zone/WSH Statement of Principle.
2. **STALLIONS:** Only Seniors (18+ years of age) may exhibit stallions.
3. **CLASS CHANGES:** Management reserves the right to cancel or combine any class that does not adequately fill, or to charge pre-entry rates for classes not adequately filled.
4. **ENTRY DEADLINES:** Post-entries will be accepted until four classes before the class you wish to enter. **Entries for the first five classes must be received before 7:30 a.m. NO phone entries accepted. All entries must be received on a Bits & Spurs entry form!!**
5. **NO REFUNDS:** Unless the show is canceled by show management or you have a veterinarian's certificate.
6. **GATE HOLDS:** gate holds must be requested on a form that is available at the show office at least four classes prior to the requested gate hold, and must be approved by show management.
7. **EQUITATION PATTERNS:** Any required patterns will be posted the morning of the show. Patterns will be created by the show judge, subject to approval by the show management.
8. **GROUPS:** Choose one group (Walk-Trot, Saddle Seat, 13 & under, 14-17, 18 & over) to compete in for daily High-Point.
9. **AWARDS:** Awards to 1st place, ribbons to fifth place in all classes; year-end points will be given to eighth place in all classes. Walk-Trot/Jog and Leadline ribbons will be awarded to eighth place.
10. **HIGH-POINTS:** High-Point and Reserve High Point ribbons will be given each show. 3 Western age groups, 3 English age groups, 2 combined English/Western Walk/Trot (1 - 10 & under and 1 - 11 & over) and one Saddle Seat. 1 rider/1 horse combination to count for each high-point. High Point awards will only be awarded for groups with 3 or more people in them. For example if the 13 & under group only has 2 rider/horse combinations in it that group will not be eligible for a high point award.
11. ****SERIES HIGHPOINT AWARD: Must be a current member in good standing. Must attend 3 out of the 4 regular shows. Double judged show in July counts as one show. All classes with the exception of green horse to count. Exhibitors must show in a minimum of 3 classes per seat. Points from all classes to count, there will be an obvious advantage if an exhibitor attends all shows.**
12. **CLASS SPECIFICATIONS:** This show is approved by Evergreen Zone. For specifications of approved classes, see the current Evergreen Zone rulebook. Bits and Spurs Year End Awards Brochures are available through show management free of charge to current members, and EV Zone books to Zone members for \$5.00.
13. **LEADLINE/WALK-TROT:** Leadline will run at 12:00pm, not before. Walk-Trot shall follow printed class order. Leadline requires handler to be 18 years of age or over.
14. **REQUIRED ATTIRE:** Club Grounds Rules state that boots must be worn in both arenas. Junior exhibitors must wear helmets at all times when mounted on horse or pony – regardless of seat ridden. Refer to Zone Rule Book for required attire during Zone-approved shows.
15. **JUNIOR HORSE:** Defined as a horse 5 years and under. May be ridden in a snaffle or bosal in Equitation and Pleasure classes with two hands if horse has never been shown in a shank bit.
16. **GREEN HORSE:** Defined as a horse that is in its first or second year of showing in that particular discipline.
17. **WARM-UP ARENA:** the warm-up arena is for warming up before classes – no stopping or standing permitted.
18. **CONCESSIONS:** Beverages and snacks available for purchase– watch our web site for any updates.

20. **YEAR-END AWARDS:** To be eligible for a Year-End award, an exhibitor must compete in 2 of the Equitation, and 2 of the Performance classes, in at least 3 separate shows per season. Current Award Divisions are in the Bits & Spurs Rule Book, or posted at the Show Booth.
21. **INCENTIVE:** As an incentive to exhibitors that Pre-Enter our shows, classes added on show days will be available to them at Pre-Entry prices. **Minimum of four classes must be pre-entered to qualify for pre-entry prices on show day.**
22. **OPEN CHECKS:** All participants that pay with an open check will be charged at minimum for four classes. Open checks will not be accepted for pre-entry.
23. **PRE-ENTRY RATE:** Payment MUST accompany entry in order to qualify for pre-payment rate.
24. **TRAIL IN HAND:** is open only to horses never shown under saddle, you may not cross enter with the mounted trail classes.
25. **TRAIL COUNTING TOWARD HIGHPOINT:** Both trail age group and open can counts for highpoint.
26. Multiple riders may use the same horse in different age groups.
27. **Any questions arising that are not covered shall be decided by show management and all are final.**
